With his unique insight into the economic and political developments in Yemen, he is able to provide us with an up-to-date overview of what has been happening in the country since he last spoke to us in January 2008.

The Port of Aden is central to Yemen's economic fortunes. Yemen is the poorest country in the Middle East, but is pursuing a reform programme designed to boost the private sector and reduce poverty. The government is giving priority to improving the investment climate and strengthening democratic institutions. International aid pledges worth US\$4.7 billion for the period 2007-2010 together with oil revenues provide the main funds driving these reforms.
